



## ONEPETRO TERMS OF USE – INDIVIDUAL SUBSCRIBERS

---

1. As the managing organization for OnePetro, the Society of Petroleum Engineers (hereinafter "SPE") grants you (hereinafter "Subscriber") the right to access the purchased individual subscription package of articles (hereinafter the "Subscription") available through the OnePetro (collectively, hereinafter "Licensed Material") subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
2. Subscription access to OnePetro Licensed Materials will be granted once full payment is received. Subscriber may download up to the number of papers that was specified in the Subscription. All access to the Subscription will be terminated exactly twelve months after the subscription has been activated and any unused downloads will be forfeited.
3. **Permitted Uses**
  - 3.1 Provided Subscriber is in good standing hereunder, Subscriber is permitted to:
    - 3.1.1 Search, view, retrieve and display the purchased number of Licensed Material on OnePetro.org.
    - 3.1.2 Electronically save the Licensed Material for personal use.
    - 3.1.3 Print off single copies of parts of the Licensed Material.
    - 3.1.4 Create multiple copies of extracts of the Licensed Material for classroom instruction use, consistent with the "fair use" provisions of section 107 of the US Copyright Act. Each such copy shall carry appropriate acknowledgment of the source, listing title and author of extract, title and author of work, and publisher.
4. **Prohibited Uses**
  - 4.1 Subscriber may not remove or alter the authors' names, copyright notices, trademarks, or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Material.
  - 4.2 Subscriber may not systematically make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts of the Licensed Material for any purpose other than is approved in writing in advance by SPE.
  - 4.3 Subscriber may not display or distribute any part of the Licensed Material on any electronic or other data network including, without limitation, the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than is approved in writing in advance by SPE.
  - 4.4 The individual publisher's explicit written permission must be obtained in order to:
    - 4.4.1 Reproduce the whole or any part of the Licensed Material for any Commercial Use.
    - 4.4.2 Make available or distribute the whole or part of the Licensed Material to anyone other than the Subscriber.
    - 4.4.3 Publish, distribute or make available the Licensed Material or works which combine it with any other material, other than as permitted in this License.
    - 4.4.4 Alter, abridge, adapt or modify the Licensed Material, except to the extent necessary to make it perceptible on a computer screen, or as otherwise permitted in this License. Unless specifically authorized in writing by the publisher or the copyright holder, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted.
5. Subscriber will use its best efforts to ensure that only the Subscriber is permitted access to the Licensed Material.
6. SPE will use all reasonable efforts to make the Licensed Materials available to Subscriber at all times and on a twenty-four hour basis, save for routine maintenance and down-time, and to restore access to the Licensed Material as soon as reasonably possible in the event of an interruption or suspension of the service. SPE will make all reasonable efforts to notify Licensee of scheduled downtime at least 24 hours in advance.

The individual publishers in OnePetro will not be responsible for any claim, loss or liability attributable to errors, inaccuracies or other defects in the Licensed Material or any part thereof whether arising from any intentional act or omission or (to the maximum extent permitted by relevant laws) any negligence.
8. SPE's maximum liability to Licensee hereunder is limited to the fee paid by Licensee to SPE for the then current Subscription Period.
9. SPE reserves the right at any time to withdraw from the Licensed Material any item or part of an item for which it has reasonable grounds to believe does or may infringe upon or misappropriate the intellectual property rights of a third party.
10. Subscriber may not assign or transfer any rights under these Terms.
11. SPE reserves the right to suspend and/or terminate access to OnePetro upon violation of this agreement.
